

First Aid Certifications

The following First Aid Certifications are those which comply with the requirements of the AS/NZS 2299.1 Standard. In addition to complying with the Standard, these certifications are also approved as a pre-requisite for ADAS training with an Accredited Training Establishment (ATE), and for applications submitted directly to ADAS.

The certifications shown below are available through Australian based First Aid providers.
